New Features/Functionality:

- 1) Added new SSH-based job type to support for backing up virtual machines running on VMware vSphere Hypervisor ("ESXi free").
- 2) Added ability to exclude one or more virtual machine hard disks from backup.
- 3) Added ability to disable temporary password file encryption.
- 4) Added ability to set custom timeout for create and remove temporary snapshot tasks.
- 5) Added ability to change compression level of backups.
- 6) Added process to clean up after backup job failures.

Improvements:

- 1) Added information on files backed up and transfer rate to log entry and notification message.
- 2) Added compression information to log entry and notification message.
- 3) Revised notification message subject to make it easier to determine success/fail of job without need to open message.

Improvements to Client Interface:

- 1) Added compression information backup list (new column called "Compression Ratio").
- 2) Set sorting to ascending on e-mail notification recipients list.

Bugs Repaired:

- 1) Revised process that downloads virtual machine configuration file to encode VMX file address into URL safe format (to account for special characters/symbols in name of virtual machine folder, VMX file and/or datastore).
- 2) Revised process that downloads virtual machine hard disks to account for quotes in the name of datastore, virtual machine folder and/or virtual disk files.
- 3) Corrected lines in log entry and notification that were missing line feed.

Bugs Repaired in Client Interface:

- 1) Corrected setting validation for replication jobs to look for completed Converter Server setting (vs. VMware vCenter Converter Standalone Application Directory).
- 2) Added check for existing duplicate e-mail address when adding e-mail notification recipient.

Important Changes to Note:

- 1) Extended expiration date to 9/30/2013.
